March 11th 2011, at 2:26 pm, a massive earthquake with an estimated magnitude of 9.0 struck the northern coast of Japan. Within minutes, a monster Tsunami of 10 meters height pounded the archipelago. More than 20,000 people are estimated killed or missing. In this program, we hear first-hand accounts from the people who actually lived through this double disaster together with footage which captured unbelievably horrifying moments. The result is a powerful and terrifying reminder of the power of nature's wrath.

This program follows the survivor's lives just after the disaster, including the people still looking for their loved ones.
